ARBOR DAY TREE PLANTING CELEBRATION IN SEA ISLE CITY ON APRIL 28

SEA ISLE CITY, NJ – The Sea Isle City Historical Society will host a special Arbor Day Celebration on Friday, April 28, at 12 noon, at which time an Ornamental Cherry Tree will be planted in the Sea Isle City Historical Museum’s Memorial Garden, located on the grounds of the Sea Isle City Library, 4800 Central Avenue.
