SEA ISLE CITY'S 2016 BEACHCOMBER TOUR SEASON BEGINS JUNE 21 – MUCH TO THE DELIGHT OF FAMILIES AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENTHUSIASTS

SEA ISLE CITY, NJ – Sea Isle's Beachcomber Tour Guides will begin their 2016 tour season on June 21.

Led by volunteers who share a passion for the beach and aquatic life, Beachcomber Tours are one-hour excursions that are as informative as they are enjoyable. At a cost of only \$1 per person, the family-friendly environmental walks along the sand give tour-takers the opportunity to explore the beach and learn interesting facts about the surrounding environment.

Each child who takes a tour receives a free sand pail and Sara the Turtle Coloring Book. At the end of each tour, participants take an oath to protect the environment and keep the beaches clean.

According to Beachcomber organizer Eleanor Moore, the tours are very popular with children and adults alike.

"We share a great amount of information during our tours," says Moore, who has been a Beachcomber for 16 years. "Our goal is to remind everyone how delicate our beaches and waterways are as we explain the wide variety of sea life that lives in the local eco-system."

Weather permitting, Beachcomber Tours take place promptly at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday mornings on the 29th Street Beach (June 21 through August 23) and on Thursday mornings on the 94th Street Beach in the Townsend Inlet Waterfront Park (June 23 through August 25). No pre-registration is required – simply show-up and join the fun!
