ORDINANCE NO. 940 (1988)

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE, CONTROL AND PROHIBIT
THE DUMPING OF WASTE WITHIN THE CITY OF SEA
ISLE CITY AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE
VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the City of Sea Isle City,
Cape May County, New Jersey, DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The use or maintenance of any waste disposal within the City of Sea Isle City other than those areas, if any, officially established by New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection permit or officially designated by the City of Sea Isle City shall constitute a detriment to the public health and a nuisance.

SECTION 2. No person, firm or corporation whether acting as contractor, agent, employee, collector or owners shall dump, deposit or dispose of any garbage, animal matter, refuse, rubbish debris, salvage or waste material in or upon any lands anywhere within the City of Sea Isle City other than the designated and permitted areas.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon trial and conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$500.00 for each and every such violation, plus the cost of clean-up or community service work for a period of not less than 30 days, but not to exceed 270 days or imprisonment for a term not to exceed 90 days or any combination of these penalties. Each day upon which a violation of this Ordinance shall continue to exist, shall be deemed a separate offense.

SECTION 4. Any person assisting in the conviction of a violator of this Ordinance through the signing of a complaint, the giving of testimony in Court, or other significant assistance of the enforcement authorities thereof or who testifies in Court in an action against an alleged violator of this Ordinance resulting in conviction, shall receive a reward of \$250.00.

SECTION 5. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall refer and apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall remain valid and effective.

SECTION 6. All other Ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are expressly repealed hereby to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as provided by law.
