ORDINANCE NO. 1717 (2024)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SEA ISLE CITY, CHAPTER 2 ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE NEW JERSEY POLICE LICENSURE ACT

WHEREAS, Chapter 2 of the City of Sea Isle City Code establishes the Department of Police for the City of Sea Isle and outlines the composition of the Department and the criteria that must be met for an individual to obtain employment with the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2022, Governor Philip Murphy enacted the New Jersey Police Licensure Act, N.J.S.A. 52: 17B-66 et seq., which establishes a police licensing program for all New Jersey law enforcement officers, and which will require that all law enforcement officers hold a valid, active license issued by the Police Training Commission (PTC) in order to be employed as officers in the State of New Jersey. The provisions of the Act go into effect on January 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate to amend the City Code to ensure compliance with these new requirements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Sea Isle City, County of Cape May and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION I. Chapter 2 Section 9A.12 of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Sea Isle City entitled "Police Training Course; Successful Completion Prerequisite to Permanent Appointment" is hereby amended to change the title and add the following section, letter "d" in its entirety as follows:

DELETED SECTION:

2-9A.12. Police Training Course; Successful Completion Prerequisite to Permanent Appointment

REPLACEMENT SECTION:

2-9A.12. Police Training Course and Licensure; Successful Completion Prerequisite to Permanent Appointment

- d. Pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Police Licensure Act, N.J.S.A. 52:17B-66 et seg., effective January 1, 2024, all current and future law enforcement officers employed by the Police Department of the City of Sea Isle City must bold a valid, active license issued by the Police Training Commission (PTC) in order to be employed as a police officer.
- **SECTION II.** Severability. If for any reason any section of this Ordinance shall be declared illegal by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining section of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, notwithstanding.

SECTION III. Repealer. Any Ordinance or provision thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION IV. Publication. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the adoption and publication in accordance with the law.
